

The Sightsavers Dolphin Pen Treaty



The Sightsavers Dolphin Pen is the result of a unique collaboration between Sightsavers international and Dolphin Computer Access.

Launched in May 2007, the Sightsavers Dolphin Pen offers blind and low vision computer users complete portability of their access software. Screen reader and magnification software are carried on a USB pen drive and can be used on any computer running Windows XP or

Vista.

This unique international initiative allows national disability organisations and certain other agencies to procure the pen at a special subsidised price. These organisations can then distribute the pen within their national development programmes. The Sightsavers Dolphin Pen is NOT a commercial product for sale to the general public.

In country distributors are under this agreement allowed to add a nominal surcharge of not more than 10 per cent of the cost of the pen in order to recover their costs in handling and distribution

Any individual or agency signing this agreement hereby agrees to act in accordance with the above conditions. Dolphin Computer Access and Sightsavers International routinely monitor participation and any deviation from the above conditions may result in the agreement being terminated.
